## A Special Compartment in Hell: Slate.Com-- Cyberbully Victim Deserved It

So what? She deserved it?

So now court documents reveal that Phoebe Prince, the teen who killed herself in response to being bullied, was a troubled young woman on seroquel and a cutter and probably succumbed to suicidal ideation as a result of a pre-existing condition and not--so "The Journalist" breaking the story would have us believe--cyberbullying.

The Journalist details the young woman as a sick puppy who deserved the animal abuse she received:

*My investigation into the events that gave rise to Phoebe's death, based on extensive interviews and review of law enforcement records, reveals the uncomfortable fact that Phoebe helped set in motion the conflicts with other students that ended in them turning on her. Her death was tragic, and she shouldn't have been bullied. But she was deeply troubled [oh, if that's the case, it's ok then] long before she ever met the six defendants. And her own behavior made other students understandably upset.—The Journalist*

Is this the pre-existing condition clause in the Constitution? What, are HMOs selling themselves as journalists these days? *You're denying the claim, then, madam?*

I take it we're to view the bullying which focused itself on a tortured young woman to be a public service, a mercy killing ending her suffering, or as neurophilosopher Paul Churchland might put it, a case of "normal" kids driving the miscreant from the sandbox. Is that it?

What next? Euthanasia for troubled teens?

The so-called journalist who broke news of these documents appeared on the Today Show Wednesday morning and tried to portray her position as, by some miracle, more sophisticated than prior coverage of the story has been. "It's more complicated than just a black and white case of bullying," The Journalist purred.

In reality, her position on this episode of good old-fashioned, traditional American brutality is pomographically moronic. Her misguided attempt at blowback management winds up being bully advocacy. And it isn't really a nuanced position. Here it is in a nutshell:

Phoebe Prince was mentally ill. Ergo, she deserved it.

I get that *The Journalist* was attempting to counteract overreaction and advocate for leniency for the bullies. Why that project must include an assault on the victim based on bias against the mentally ill is beyond me. How do you win mercy for the accused by justifying the victim's target status?

There is something especially sick about it. I said sick and not surprising.

This slop is generated by a mainstream media that sees no problem with torture, obeys every command the DoD gives it, covers up Abu Ghraib, collateral murder, and the Gaza Flotilla Massacre and waves the flag to dispense with every ugly demonstration of devolved American cruelty it is forced to deal with by nontraditional journalistic sources.

Why should it have a problem with debunking victims of bullies?

It is all just kids behaving normally, luxuriating in the cruelty native to the human soul and the crowning feature of contemporary Americana.

girl drama,” as several kids put it to me. And though it’s hard to say so, because nobody, rightly, wants to blame the girl who died, many kids see it as normal girl drama that Phoebe contributed to.—*The Journalist*

There is something seriously wrong with “normal Girl drama.” There is something seriously wrong with America. There is something seriously wrong with this Journalist. I think she needs to be put on [seroquel](#). There is something seriously wrong with NBC for broadcasting her views.

There is something seriously wrong, in other words, with excusing bullying on the implied basis that, after all, the victim WAS a freak.

*Should teenagers be held responsible for acting out toward a girl who turned out to be far more unstable than any of them truly understood?—The Journalist*

No, no, not at all. We are all honor bound to rid society of the unstable. These bullies are national heroes. We need a freakless America. Freaks weigh the rest of us down. They are a heavy burden on the taxpayer, after all.

Well, the implications of that are clear. We now have permission to seek out the mentally ill, the homeless, the crippled, and the aged and kick the crap out of them and not live in fear of prosecution. Someone from Slate.com will go on Today Show and tout the social utility of ridding ourselves of the expense of dealing with the constitutionally unfit, thereby making the perpetrator out to be a victim.

*Oh, its okay then. She was a sick, troubled weirdo. It was all right to bully her.*

To paraphrase the great Christopher Walken in [The Dead Zone](#): *It was not all right. It was not okay.*

*Awh, come on, the bully apologists say. In a Social Darwinistic kind of way, bullying winnows out the weak. We can’t have weak people in “America.” Where will we get our harsh interrogators, our extraordinary renditioneers, our Commander Centcoms, if we put bullies in jail? It is all right. It is okay.*

It is not all right. It is not okay.

*Getting a kick out of bullying is as American as Apple Pie and we ought therefore not to be ashamed of enjoying it. Knowing that my bullying spree will be celebrated by the Today Show gives me the cover I need to give the freaks the proper pummeling their inferior genetic make-up requires. To paraphrase the old high school cheer: It’s all right. It’s okay. We will whup their asses anyway!*

It is not all right. It is not okay.

If we follow the eugenical pre-existing-condition argument put forward by Slate.com and its bully apologist, we are honor bound, then, to begin instituting a policy of surgical strikes on teen failures, starting with those on medication and then seeking out and destroying those in institutions or halfway houses. Reward points go to the bully who delivers the most humiliating verbal or physical beating, like in the video game where you get to select the choicest humiliations after you vanquish your opponent.

Humiliation is, after all, the chief American Export. See Iraq. See Abu Ghraib. See Bagram Air Force Base.

We can name it the *Miscreant Elimination Program*, in honor of Mr. Churchland.

*In the end, the next chapter of the South Hadley bullying story isn’t really about innocence versus guilt. It’s about proportional versus disproportional punishment. All of the kids accused of hurting Phoebe Prince have been kicked out of school. They have been the focus of intense, public rage. They’ve been blamed for the suicide of a vulnerable, troubled girl. They will live with this always. Maybe that is already enough.—The Journalist*

How humane. With Phoebe conveniently dead, *The Journalist* need not show her any mercy. She focuses her compassion on the people who psychologically tortured her. They are still alive. Why waste your compassion on the dead?

It isn’t apparent that *The Journalist* has a child. It isn’t likely, judging from the position she takes in the piece, that she has ever been bullied. Perhaps she should have subjected herself to a dose or two of it to truly get a sense of how deeply humiliating it is. Maybe she went to private school.

Maybe she was a bully.

But I guess Slate has grown tired of listening to parents’ sob stories about their kids

being bullied. It isn't as if I believe these bully kids should get the death penalty, but they ought not to emerge with suspended sentences and a tour of duty shelving books at the Public Library, either. It is one thing to make a plea for leniency. It is quite another to imply troubled teens deserve to be bullied or worse.

*The Journalist* rightly examines the role of the school system in the tragedy. And, indeed, for anyone out there curious as to where American Cruelty gets cultivated, the proving grounds can be found in the American School System. That is where the hate gets forged. You want to know why we so easily take to torture and humiliation like fish to water read up on the American Public School System. It is the most efficient human misery maker ever devised.

Why she didn't keep to that critique and instead focused on rehabilitating the perpetrators is puzzling.

Maybe that is why *The Journalist* quotes [Alan Dershowitz](#), renowned perpetrator apologist, to aid her cause. Dershowitz is a well-compensated past master of the victim-perpetrator switcheroo (see the O.J. Simpson Case), a self-anointed critic of sob stories, and, tellingly, the author of [The Abuse Excuse](#). That Dershowitz is being deployed here suggests something slightly askew with the intent of this report. I mean, I believe this piece is essentially psychologically sick, but you can't ignore the possibility that it is merely pretrial deliberations.

In other words, It may have more to do with the Defense Attorneys floating trial balloons out to test argumentation than anything so noble as a plea for leniency by *The Journalist*.

Leniency was not something that was afforded to Phoebe by the accused.

The question is: Who is sickest? The troubled teen who took her own life in protest of a brutal world or the brutally ignorant journalists who exemplify everything that is morally sickest about that world by implying Phoebe deserved what happened to her?

Phoebe Prince is free now of that sick world.

The rest of us get to be tortured by the bullying moral retardation of NBC News, Slate.com, *The Journalist*, and Alan Dershowitz.

It wasn't all right. It wasn't okay.

refused a plea - good for him I say) and was found NOT GUILTY on all counts! Scheibel brought a weak, vindictive case against someone who never should have been indicted in the first place.

Another embarrassment for her is 'Pottygate'. This turned out to be Scheibel's political swansong and she's not running for D.A. again in November. She became so insensed when a court official had a court officer open her locked office to retrieve the toilet key, that she called in the state police and assembled a grand jury to indict the court official! Nothing was stolen from her office and the key had been quickly returned after an attorney used the locked bathroom. But, Scheibel called it burglary/breaking and entering.

When reporters from the Boston Globe wrote an article on it, she subpoenaed them as well as their quickly hired defense attorneys! A higher court quashed the subpoenas, making a fool out of her. And the case against the court official was eventually dropped.

With a D.A. like this, the Prince family won't get justice. The same school officials, teachers and counselors are still in place. Frankly it's them who should be on trial as far as I'm concerned.
