Veteran Investigator Matt Graeber Interviews Emma Woods: Interview Summary

I think Miss Woods has offered readers a very detailed look behind-the-scenes of American abduction researching. She may have even provided us with several insights we hadn't had beforehand regarding the plight, fears, and concerns of a "social stigma" being associated with the abductees' reported experiences.

Is this justified and something skeptics have caused or a cruel product of researcher coercion?

Anyway, this may be as mean spirited as off-handedly dismissing depression or various phobias people have been known to suffer. I am not implying Miss Woods's experiences are linked to mental or emotional disorders of some kind. Rather, what I am saying is, I do not know the cause of her experiences and that the so-called abduction experts may have exacerbated her suffering, concerns, and fears with their shoddy self-taught research techniques and cavalier attitudes towards the experiencers.

I ask: Where are the safeguards and protocols of responsible researching?

Proclamations such as "an extraordinary phenomenon DEMANDS an extraordinary inquiry" may sound like a great UFOlogical excuse to some folks, but serious problems can and do arise when such rhetoric is embraced and put into practice by individuals who have set aside the humanity of their research subjects and perceive them as mere book fodder or juicy UFO conference presentation stories.

If we start with the "assumption" the reported experiences are psychological in nature, rather than being caused by alien kidnappings and abuse with all the assumed black-magical powers the aliens must employ to pull off the logistical marvel of locating, kidnapping, and subjecting so many individuals to medical procedures and then covertly returning literally hundreds of thousands of victims to the own beds with their underwear on properly (except in a few isolated instances)—well, I am certain you see the point!

I personally like the notion of exploring this subject from the angle of the "imagery perceived and reacted to" by the experiencers. For example, imagery that appears in dreams falls well into the domain of psychology and psychiatry, as dream analysis is a valuable therapeutic tool often used by professionals with their patients.

In fact, there may be specialists in the analysis of paranormal imagery. Emma tells us her ex-therapist thought he might contact one on her behalf. I have consulted the W.W.W. seeking such an analyst and discovered they basically come in two distinct varieties. Skeptics, like Dr. Marks of New Zealand (a professional), and Paranormalists, who happen to believe in ghosts, hauntings, demons, spirits, and UFOs, etc. So, as one might imagine, I have decided to avoid adding controversy to the topic by mentioning these sources for they would immediately be assailed and criticized by skeptics and/or UFOlogists!

So, I shall present thoughts of my own on the subject and weather whatever storms of rejection and ridicule may sprout, for one reason or another, while also hoping to have learned something of value from the experience.

I guess the abduction phenomenon as it is presently portrayed in the saucer literature leaves little choice on the matter so here goes.

in which upon awakening one had some difficulty determining if the dream was of a real-life (past) event or, if it were just a dream production. Secondly, as a child, we may have had "imaginary friends" which were pleasurable to be with and with which we may have shared many childhood experiences. Some researchers have reported that such

imaginary friends were often given milk to drink, candy and cookies to eat with the children. Additionally, as the child matured, his or her imaginary playmates disappeared, as what psychologists call the child's "soft boundaries" (between fantasy and reality) "solidified" and the child became an adult.

Moreover, not all of the imaginary friends were humans. Some were animals like baby elephants and ponies, etc. So, if we might think of ancient mythologies, Egyptian and Grecian gods, half animal-half human being types, it is not too difficult to conceive of a half alien-half human creature, too. These may be the "Hybrids" of the abduction lore - that is, if they are what have caused the ancient stories, perceptions, and beliefs to reemerge in modern times.

We also know that, in abductee descriptions, the Grays, or the small bulbous-headed alien abductors, and the hybrid fetuses during early developmental stages are reported to be listless, emotionless, emaciated, and have whitish-blond hair sparsely distributed over their craniums. They look very much like sick little infants on chemo with enormous and lifeless black eyes. They

bear a striking resemblance to an aborted embryonic fetus. In fact, they are reported to be stored in liquid-filled jars or rectangular see-thru glass coffins or boxes, aboard the colossal (pregnant?) mother ships. That the American abduction phase of UFOlogy roughly coincided with the great abortion controversy in America should not be over-looked. But, like the abductologists, I can offer no proof these things are related. But two OB/GYN professionals have determined that no private practice, clinical or hospital medical documentation exists to support the so-called "missing fetus syndrome" and police authorities are not receiving missing persons reports at an alarming rate, despite the hundreds of thousands of abductions being written about by UFO experts.

But, Emma Woods seems to be an experiencer (abductee) who has not reported the loss of a fetus to an assumed alien cross-breeding program. Instead, she was selected to collect the sperm of hybrids, half human-half alien male creatures and lusty male abductees, too. This seems to be a gross contradiction of Dr. Jacobs hypnotic suggestion because, the highly advanced and intelligent aliens could have simply kept the male hybrids and human abductees aboard their ships and collected all the spermatozoa they needed for cross-breeding, without running the risks of detection by Earth's police authorities or the possible flood of rape reports filed by frightened experiencers. Dr. Jacobs seems to have committed the fatal flaw of assigning the aliens no adherence to the rule of law and, while there may be very different codes of conduct on an alien world, the commission of crimes by half-humans and humans on planet earth may not be excusable. Perhaps, Dr. Jacobs feels the visiting aliens should be granted diplomatic immunity by the newly appointed "take me to your leader" representative at the U.N. Moreover, when Dr. Jacobs suggested Miss Woods perform various sex acts with male hybrids and abductee males, no one had yet been appointed to the post of handling E.T./Human relations at the U.N. and, considering the rather dismal success rate of the United Nations with handling Earth's Human conflicts over the years, that may be a good thing.

However, I have found, during this extended interview process with Miss Emma Woods, whom I have not met personally (and obviously she mistrusts UFOlogists), that she displays no obvious behaviors of Multiple Personality Disorder (M.P.D.) in her e-mails. She is very even-tempered, cordial, and polite. I think to say otherwise about her is malicious and slanderous at the very least.

During my hypnosis sessions with Dr. Jacobs I recalled "aliens" performing gynecological

procedures on me. I think that these memories were almost certainly confabulated following his suggestion.

unskilled, shoddy practitioner of regressive hypnosis who obviously believes in alien abductions and his own self-proclaimed expertise. He tends to "lead and demand" research subjects to provide "confirming" details to bolster his own

beliefs, theories, and agenda. If the research subject should fail to do so, *HE MAY SIMPLY ALTER WHATEVER THEY HAVE SAID.*

This kind of "transference" and "projection" are well-known to psychologists and psychiatrists and might be illustrated by Dr. James Hillman, the brilliant American Jungian analyst and author, who has this to say about a similar form of the behavior in an interview with Italian journalist Laura Pozzo (a pseudonym). From Dr. Hillman's 1983 book titled 'Inter views' page 52. Ms Pozzo and Dr. Hillman were discussing the relationship of the analyst (=abductologist) and his/her patient (=abductees) in regard to analyzing their dream images (=aliens and hybrid creature descriptions).

"The patient, you, me is only relatively real. The images are what really count, and they get so little place in our world [except for within the UFO/Paranormal literature and sub-culture] so my job is to let them speak and to speak with them. This is an idea of Jung's who said 'In a certain way the figures are real as we are real.'"

Dr. Hillman continues, stating that "because you are not fully the author of your own dreams, and the authority comes from them (i.e., archetypal images) you [*the abductee or, Dr. Jacobs imagination*] speak in a sense for them [*and about them, too*]."

"If you take psychic [*or, psychical*] reality as really real—not just a bunch of complexes or the effect of society or the result of earlier development—but, just as real as the bricks and the stones and the trees, then you are limited by that reality."

Might this "limitation" sound a little like a description of D.P.P. 'Dual Process of Perception' phenomena which I have previously discussed in the online publications [SUNlite](#) and [MAGONIA](#), especially if we overlap the alien images within the real world background of the perception? [See Matt Graeber's [On Down-to-Earth UFO Experiences.](#)]

Moreover, Dr. Hillman speaks of the roll of the analyst and patient when these images (*alien memories*) emerge in therapy (*regressive conversation*) and he says *the analyst must not influence the imagery by being caught up in the patient's recollections and the patient should not be influenced by the analyst's personality or views.* Neither situation is observed in abduction research, which is little more than a hobby. It is not scientific or proto scientific in character and abductologists do not 'get out of the way' for the abductees images

Archetypal images might be ancient and multi-cultural symbols or figures such as the old man who is also a sage or the circle which is often described as a symbol of "Wholeness" or "Completeness." Dr. Hillman describes them as "[t]he eternal, essential images of the soul." No matter how one may define them, they are the archetypal images that do appear in "big dreams," the kind of vivid and strange dreams one thinks about upon awakening, wondering what they might have meant.

But, a truly "autonomous" D.P.P. function may not occur when the imagery is imbedded in the psyche through posthypnotic suggestion. Those may be products of pure confabulation or may even be a technique that could be useful to D.P.P. researchers.

Decades ago [Mr. Keith Basterfield](#), an Australian UFOlogist and several of his colleagues witnessed an abduction in progress when an abductee they accompanied in an auto described driving through an unusual landscape. Mr. Basterfield and his associates observed nothing unusual at all while, according to the abductee, the abduction continued to unfold. I wrote Mr. Basterfield about the case but he could recall few details about the incident and the case file no longer existed. This is a critical problem with sharing reports, but the internet has improved the situation somewhat.

"The projection function" is often discussed in relationship to a person who has wrongly projected upon another person, situation, or entire groups of individuals such as Bolsheviks, Free Masons, Christians, or Jews. But, in the case we are discussing, it occurred "in reverse" when Dr. Jacobs rejected abductee testimony and alien descriptions, "projecting" his own versions

upon the abductee.

I have personally witnessed him in this process.

Transference is often typified by the phenomenon of a patient fantasizing romantically and emotionally about their therapist, who is often perceived as being an intelligent, understanding, and caring authority figure. But, if the transference or infatuation should occur with an authority figure who has projected his own views into the abductees' psyche through hypnotic suggestion and explanation of their experience(s)—well, I am sure you can see the obvious dangers!

But Dr. Jung and Dr. Hillman are certainly not alone with their "archetypal imagery" ideas, and recently Emma's information crusade for justice has gained the support of UFOlogists and bloggers around the globe. Notably, long-time and well respected UFOlogist Ray Fowler has penned some very "cautionary thoughts" on the subject and blogger Gary Haden has written a "stinging" two-part article which is a "must" read for the truly objective UFOlogist. At one point he quips concerning Dr. Jacobs work "*SCHOLARLY RESEARCHING IT AINT, KANGAROO COURT IT IS.*" (See Emma's detailed reference listing for "Speculative Realms" and other abductees who feel they have been misused, abused, and are going public with their stories.)

So, the questions immediately arise: Are the consistently detailed images (*alien creatures*) Dr. Jacobs discusses in his books his or his subjects' psychical productions? Moreover, if there were a blind study and testing of his research subjects, would the alien imagery consistency percentage remain the same? As Jim Moseley of "Saucer Smear" might quip in a pithy tome: "Inquiring minds need to know!"

Unfortunately, we are left in a thick fog on this matter. But Miss Emma Woods may have provided us with the means of navigating the myth of American abduction researching. Moreover, considering all the suffering Emma reports she has gone through with several child losses, an extensive youthful surgery together with anguish and grieving, it seems that for Dr. Jacobs to have so carelessly invaded her mind with suggested tales of aliens, hybrids, and lusty male abductees, and her having had sexual liaisons with them, is not only cruel and sadistic but may be very injurious, too.

By what kind of twisted saucer-logic does he so cavalierly probe the fragile psyche of wounded people like Emma without having the benefit of formal training in psychology, psychiatry, or hypnosis, or provide any apparent safeguards for the individual against an STD or HIV infection? I personally find this to be blatantly unconscionable behavior for a so-called professor and University academician.

Dr. Jacobs once wrote a very cogent book about "The UFO Controversy in America." In that book he said (or lamented?) saucerdom's "contactee movement" as potentially being the ruination of serious UFOlogy. Years later, after forging an alliance and friendship with modern artist Budd Hopkins, Dr. Jacobs, a 20th Century American History Professor at Temple University, would help establish and embrace "the abduction movement" and thereby spare his precious UFOlogy from his perception of impending doom, but at which individual's psychical expense, *THE ABDUCTEE OR THE RESEARCHERS?* So, there are no more *CONTACTEE* stories of space ship rides to the dark side of the Moon, Venus, and the red planet Mars, packets of 400 lb. Martian Dog hairs for sale at Ozark-based UFO conventions, or reports of alien pancakes that taste like cardboard. Now, we have moved on to *TALES OF BOTH THE EARTH AND THE HUMAN WOMB BEING INVADED, PEDDLED BY ABDUCTION HOBBYISTS, THEIR UNBRIDLED DELUSIONS AND MISGUIDED SEXUAL FANTASIES!*

In closing: I'd like to mention I believe Emma's story to be entirely factual for a number of very rock-solid reasons. But, perhaps the most compelling reasons are the copies of the signed letters she received from David Jacobs and Budd Hopkins, both of which (in my opinion) were deceiving and bogus! I wish Emma well as she continues with her information campaign for justice—not only for herself and other experiencers (abductees) but, for the establishment of truth, honesty, virtue and human compassion in UFOlogy!

Normally, to be "fair and balanced" on such issues I would seek interviews with Dr. Jacobs and Mr. Hopkins so they might voice rebuttals to Emma's claims but, I doubt that will be necessary in this instance. I have visited their sites and read their phony letters they sent to Emma.
