## The Gray Alien as Tumor Capitalist: Karl Marx and Alien Abduction

**Karl Marx** doesn't really have much to do with Alien Abduction. So why import Marx into a conversation about alien abduction and gray aliens? I don't know. Why not?

I don't pretend to understand Marx or Alien Abduction. So I'm going to fake it.

To summarize Marx, the history of the world is the history of class struggle. This struggle is basically binary. It is between the bourgeoisie and the proletariat, the ruling class and the ruled class, the capitalist and the laborer, the corporation and its employees. Alienation occurs when the laborer finds his labor colonized and directed by an alien power, in this case the capitalist.

This alienation is cured through violent revolution.

Well, that sucks. How are homeless people supposed to fight a revolution? How many people are supposed to die simply because you can't get along with your boss? Isn't it better to mimic Gandhi, this time arming your revolution with disposable camcorders and camera phones to film the sins of the oppressor and post them to YouTube?

Anyway—let's let Marx steer for a while.

So there's your gross, non-exhaustive, and probably inaccurate over-simplification of Marx from a gross, non-exhaustive, over-simplified and inaccurate mind.

You can see Marx most vividly in the pompous iterations of conservative rhetoricians who pipe ear-splittingly about class warfare. Well, what this does is, it inoculates the employers of the conservative pipe organs, the capitalists, from any responsibility for their actions. So, if you're wondering who Marx is—he's the guy who provides the talking points for the republican babblers on FOX News.

Using Marxist night goggles, I think class warfare is a good place to look for alien abductions. I am quite sure this has been done before and I apologize to analysts who've traveled this road before. However, if you are reading me, I have to question your analytic seriousness.

Whatever the ontological status of Gray Aliens, they seem to make their appearance in the psychological hinterlands of the human mind. They tend to hide in hypnotic states and hypnagogic night terrors. Occasionally, trace evidence is left behind, a trail to possible physical reality. But, without a few million bucks to spend on adequate scientific investigation, those trails are usually impassable by anything other than speculation.

We're left with the Gray Alien who is a psychological artifact, a psychological work of fiction. As a work of fiction, what do they mean? What is the point?

They're like today's transnational corporations, the new superclass, the socioeconomic gated community we all live outside of: transhumans with no human affect, no limit to their exploitative powers, and unreachable, for rebellion purposes, due to their perspectival advantage. They economically occupy ground so high any complaint on our parts is shouted down by the sheer positional distance, bought by wealth, between us.

In warfare, occupy the high ground. In class warfare, the high ground is the high rent

district. No dogs allowed. We are the dogs.

Transnational corporations (TCs) behave in ways that slowly euthanize unfit humans. Though they "care about the small people," they don't have much face-to-face contact with the small people. TCs don't suffer the consequences of their actions nearly as intimately as the small people do. Closed factories throw families on to the streets. The heady Capitalist fishes up the family's foreclosed home and sells it at profit after winning a bet the unfit human blight would default on their mortgage payments.

Or the TC wipes out an entire gulf, nuking fishing industries, poisoning beaches, and eliminating tourism. Conceivably, once all the suckers who've lived in the devastated region have completed their diasporas, the TCs will move in and build casinos and warehouses.

The TC uberclass or overclass hovers like a saucer over the small people. Their perspectival superiority, as much attitude as altitude, achieves an otherness that strikes the steel worker, the fisherman, the bus driver, or the janitor, as completely and utterly alien.

The corporation's effect on life is often subliminal, beneath awareness. It is like an undetected cancer killing the organism it feeds on while the organism goes about its daily business oblivious to what is happening to it. Just as Grays operate at the borders of consciousness so do the TCs, abducting humans, confiscating their vitality, wasting that vitality in stupid repetitive tasks and windmill chases, tossing the resulting husk aside when the exploitation is consummated. You know a worker is done when his body has been worked to the state of a bag of bones, battered, in need of medical care and medical insurance, neither of which he can afford, facing a short retirement period.

Two weeks and then the grave.

Indeed, it is as socioeconomic husk that the abductee, often in economic distress if we are to believe scholars like [George Hansen](#), revisits her victimization at the hands of TCs through her symbolic reconstruction of the trauma: ET replaces the TC, the invading alien sucking out her life force, taking advantage of her complete helplessness—sleep paralysis facilitates alien abduction as economic paralysis facilitates corporate abduction. Grays take advantage of a living rigor mortis to make off with the abductee and corporations take advantage of the threat of rigor mortis to make off with the abductee's labor and, consequently, her life.

The Grays are Tumor Capitalists—parasites, like BP or Unocal or Haliburton. They abduct us to serve their purposes, whether those purposes be genetic regeneration or oil wars in the Middle East and Central Asia. The Gray is today's CEO, a visage drained of human affect, humanity constitutionally abominated through the ministrations of "late capitalism." The soulless survival-of-the-fittest philosophy at the heart of contemporary capitalist viciousness, the socioeconomic darwinism that permeates its most ardent devotees, such as the United States, where abduction reports are abundant—the TCs steal lives because they can—is also at the heart of the Grays' project.

In groping about in the dark to find out what is going on, the human mind has come up with the perfect motif to symbolize humans getting the life sucked out of them by exploitative corporate tumors: the Gray Alien ET, Tumor Capitalist, bug-eyed zombie in a labcoat, harvesting eggs from human females as TCs harvest a life's work from the common laborer, abducts because it can, because IT is the fittest, because IT, like the TC, is the Cosmic Sovereign. ETs and TCs, here, are one and the same.

"The alien being," says Karl Marx in *Estranged Labor*, "to whom labor and the produce of labor belongs, in whose service labor is done and for whose benefit the produce of labor is provided, can only be man himself."

Their ontological status is uncontested. The U.S. Supreme Court, after all, has decreed that Corporations are persons.

The Alien-Human Hybrid is, therefore, a symbol of humanity collapsing into the Alien. It means that Tumor Capitalism is transforming humans into transhumans, monsters possessed of inhuman capacities—capacities that cross borders and violate boundaries. For the capitalist to triumph, he must do what Marx felt revolutionaries had to do to triumph. He must go outside of the normal channels. In order to deploy military agents that faithfully carry out the instructions of the capitalist, the military agent must be dispossessed of any disinclination to perpetrate acts that go "outside normal channels." This is the border crossing ability of the transhuman. The transhuman can kill indiscriminately because he does not recognize the ontological worth of his target. His target is literally an avatar from a video game and not anything human and certainly not anything with a family.

In other words, inhuman acts are merely the actualizations of the transhuman-inhuman self, a truly alien being. This is a colonial-abductionist project, sanctioned now by the Supreme Court. Something that isn't human is now deemed to be human.

And if online gamers psychologically mimic their avatars, the characters they play in role-playing games, as in the [Proteus Effect of Nick Yee](#), and if the context of the game implies some sort of psychological colonization of the gamer's mind by transhuman projects, are we not creating transhuman monsters through games like Splinter Cell or Halo, transhumans who, by the time they arrive at the real battlefield, are ready to do anything, blow up anyone, torture anyone, exterminate anyone? That may be Stanley McCrystal's wet dream, but is it what we want?

Isn't human affect being revised by the pixelated avatar, internalized, or introjected, as [Melanie Klein](#) might hold, by gamers, hybridizing the human mind with inhuman affects and, consequently, inhuman behaviors?

To alienate is to take something and pervert it into something it isn't.

So, seeing through a glass darkly, we're doing the best we can in psychologically describing what is happening to us. Because we are helpless to do anything about what is happening to us, whether because of a sleep paralysis of reason or the threat of death by starvation from lack of employment, we are forced, in alien/corporate abduction, to comply. Read Karl Marx and [Ludwig Feuerbach](#), take a swig of brandy, watch Wall Street and Intruders and I think you will start to see the effect.

Your subservient existence is the shine the transhuman glosses his ego with. It doesn't matter who you are or who you think you are. You will be machined into the Alien/Corporate project. You will either be a footnote to the narcissistic glory of the Transhuman or you will die outside the confines of the corporate gated community, starved and oil-covered, a relic of human pusillanimity.

You will lay, covered in petrol, next to the rest of the dead and dying critters. You will dream of the night the aliens abducted you and took away the last shred of dignity you had.

Or so Karl Marx would have you believe.

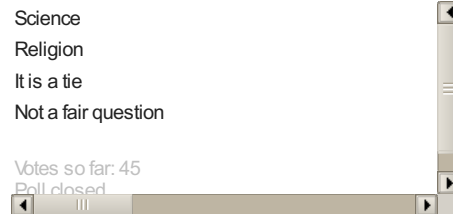
