## How to Abduct Your More-Real-Than-Real Night Terrors for the Purpose of Proving the Existence of Aliens and Make Millions in the Process

For a lot of my life, I have had weird experiences. Just looking into the mirror, for instance, is enough to produce an indescribable terror.

But the weird experiences I'm talking about are "night terrors." **Night terrors** are part of the group of sleep "disorders" labeled **parasomnias**. They include **narcolepsy**, **sleep paralysis**, sleep-wake transition disorders, **REM sleep disorders**, **arousal disorders**, **confusional arousals**, and various other things-that-go-bump-in-the-night oddities.

My night terrors usually involve a visual hallucination of an intruder. Somewhere in the hinterland between sleep and wakefulness, I see the intruder. I leap out of bed after it, or throw pillows at it, or take swings at it. Then it disappears.

This was a problem for a while. I once assaulted our dresser and the whole thing fell on me. One time I leapt toward a creature that looked like a cross between a **Jem'Hadar** from *Star Trek* and a **Killer Clown** from outer space. I ended up whamming my head against the door frame of our master bedroom bathroom. That produced a nasty little white flash in my brain.

I've learned over the years to be more circumspect about the hallucinations. I don't usually try to attack them anymore. I think the awareness that the vision is hallucinatory is now tucked away in the REM-sleep corners of my mind.

But were I to take this situation to the now-controversial alien-abduction researcher "Dr." David Jacobs, he would prep me for alien-abduction hypnosis. Why?

Well, on his alien-abduction questionnaire he poses the following interrogatories:

*While awake have you actually seen a frightening figure ("monster," a "bogeyman," a "witch," or a "Devil") as a child and/or as an adult in your bedroom, closet, or anywhere else?*

*Have you ever woken up paralyzed with a sense of a person, presence, or something else in the room?*

These are classic sleep "disorder"[1] type experiences or hallucinations with conventional explanations. The sensed-presence, in fact, has been identified as part of a vigilance system that takes effect at night when we go to bed as a protection against predators.[2] Of course, Jacobs would contend that the vigilance system, in the case of alien abductions, is activated by the presence of a real predator.

In fact, Jacobs specifically targets sleep disorders in his 1991 Roper Poll as abduction indicators.

"The number of potential abductees," he said in his book *The Threat*, "was very high—embarrassingly high:

- 18 percent had wakened paralyzed with a strange figure in the room. [a common occurrence in sleep disturbance reports]
- 15 percent had seen a terrifying figure. [another common occurrence and so incredibly nonspecific it isn't funny]

- 14 percent had left their body. [another common occurrence in sleep disturbance reports]
- 13 percent had missing time. [missing time is a common component of the sleep state itself]
- 10 percent had flown through the air. [another common sleep disorder report]
- 8 percent had seen unusual lights in the room.
- 8 percent had puzzling scars.
- 7 percent had seen a UFO.
- 5 percent had dreams of UFOs.
- 1 percent said the "trondant" had special significance for them."<sup>[3]</sup>

Only the bottom four percentages have anything to do with UFOs, not counting the control line about the word "trondant." The top percentages are sleep-related phenomena that Jacobs identifies as "events consistent with those that abductees experienced before they knew they were abductees."<sup>[4]</sup> How they come to know they were abductees is, of course, through their indoctrination through hypnosis.<sup>[5]</sup>

It is no accident that many sleep disorders that would explain some of the weird things people experience feature exceptionally vivid hallucinations that, at least in the case of the narcoleptic, "may incorporate all the senses—touch, taste, scent, hearing, and vision. They may also involve a sense of movement or include elements of the person's environment in the imagery portrayed. Frequently, the hallucinations are frightening or bizarre, which can lead to fear for their sanity."<sup>[6]</sup>

We are here talking about total spectrum, high-definition hallucinations featuring movement and an integrated sleep-waking environment. Just because the experience gives testimony to banal brain states we all go into and is explainable in terms of sleep research and science doesn't mean it isn't bizarre and terrifying.

Some might say the experience is just too fantastic to be reduced to sleep dysfunction. There is a natural tendency to want to retain an experience's fantasticality because one is bored with scientific terminology or excessively clinical nomenclature. I know I am.

The Killer Klowns<sup>[7]</sup> that appear at the foot of my bed are, to me, a threat that must be dealt with and they produce a terror in me that is more intense than anything I ever feel in waking life. The man in the white coat may tell me they're just hypnagogic hallucinations born from sleep-wake source confusion and, perhaps, hypoglycemia, but he never saw one of them and I doubt he'd hold his water if he did.

Sleep disorders, which have very earthly, neuroscientific, and perhaps exceedingly boring explanations, can produce psychological events as arresting as any purported, full-blown alien abduction.

Their fantasticality, however, is not an excuse to exploit them for the purpose of proving the existence of aliens. Their extremely accurate reality mimicry is a convenient highway to the perverting contention that "they feel so real because they ARE real!"

That is the perversion upon which Jacobs's research depends. He is guilty of exploiting sleep disorders for the purpose of lending credence to his science fiction. This exploitation outfits all his books with lucrative potential. He is like L. Ron Hubbard in that regard.

Emma Woods has caught him in the act.

"All exploitation is abuse."<sup>[8]</sup>

[5] "What turns the reality-monitoring problem into a full-blown abduction story? In almost every case, the tool of choice is hypnosis. Newman and Baumeister cite a study by Bullard (1989) in which 71% of 104 'high quality' abduction stories were produced under hypnosis.... Yet decades of research on hypnotically induced memory reveal that hypnosis does not result in increased memory accuracy but merely increased output. Hypnotically induced testimony has been ruled inadmissible in most courts, because it greatly increases the witness's vulnerability to suggestion and because it is based on a false theory of memory. Hypnagogia is a hypnotic state. You get two good deals, if you're from the hypnosis wing. You get an excellent hypnotic subject—one. And you get access to the subject's hallucinatory material. You then can hypnotically rework that material so it takes on the costuming of an abduction narrative.

Every fiber in my being tells me the thing exists. But it obviously doesn't.

It is this experiential conviction that Jacobs, I believe, takes advantage of. I don't know if he does it purposely or not. He certainly is arrogant enough to try.

I think sleep disorders are strange enough experiences without turning them into alien abduction narratives.

Folks who have waking recall are a different kettle of fish and they tend to be more believable to me.
