Paracast Mans Up

I was astonished to hear what I was hearing on the Paracast Prologue for May 23, 2010.

Perhaps I should not have been. Paul Kimball, the Paracast co-host for the May 23rd show, after all, has investigated the value of hypnosis in abduction research in the past. He has traditionally advocated a critical stance toward the practice. So it is not surprising to hear Kimball take a strong stance against David Jacobs's behavior in the Emma Woods affair.

In fact, Kimball details in the Prologue a lot of what is wrong with abduction research and research into the paranormal in general. A lot of people in the field drink the kool-aid. Kimball obviously drinks the coffee.

Gene Steinberg apparently has had a cup as well.

Look, I have clashed with Steinberg in the past over the Emma Woods case. I think he was hard on Emma.
