The Paranoid Porn of the Repto-Religionists and a Big Fish Story

Interestingly, one of the lecturer's websites deploys a URL with the word "whale" in it. Perhaps it is a simple redirect attempt or perhaps it is a bit of sadistic sarcasm meant to mock the intelligence of people who suffer the misfortune of imbibing his poisons.

Maybe it is his way of saying don't mind my big fish story. Since he hasn't bothered to identify himself I won't bother to identify him either.

Of course, you don't find verification of his employment history on his websites so, like everything else he says, you have to take him at his word. This appears to be standard practice in the community. You are many times cornered into having to take people on their word alone. That way they don't have to prove anything.

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mouth, can bore a hole into your cerebral cortex and make you extremely susceptible to suggestion.

Well, all kidding aside, rape is a crime. How convenient for people who don't want to be constrained by proof requirements that no description of the assailant can be provided. You can't report it to the police because you can't describe the assailant. That keeps proper investigations out of the way.

What we want to assert is the *absolute powerlessness* of human beings before this all-powerful dino from outer space. How scared could we make them if they had a way to alleviate their fears? We can't take advantage of calm, cool, and collected people. We need them disoriented and oblivious.

In other words, the victim is stuck with his/her experience and with alien-abduction researchers. You shut off access to sleep doctors, to the police, to psychotherapists in order to subject experiencers to the quackery of "the community." It is a neat little trap and paranoia is the cheese. The only avenue left to experiencers after the quacks have debunked mainstream means of falsification, which would alleviate the paranoia, is to disclose the experience to "the community." Luckily enough for abductionists, the paranoia you're roiling in thermodynamically degrades your ability to think and the life-draining worldview avatars such as the lecturer wish to cultivate in the masses becomes *YOUR Weltanschauung*.

Because it provides certain ego perks, you get a kick out of it. You think you're getting ego reinforcement. What is actually happening is a mockery of ego reinforcement. It is profound contempt for your psychological well-being masquerading as lovefest. You may think your life has been saved. Uh hunh.

Well, it is up to you. I mean you have a right to mess up your own life. But it would be unfortunate if you took that route.

Because essentially you've *lost your life*. Its *structural integrity* has been breached.

Paranoia in "the community" is the gift that keeps on giving. In a sense, the lecturer is like the vindictive AIDs victim whose free-floating rage gets funneled into a form of slow serial killing by sleeping with multiple partners. He's spreading the love.

I understand the wish to believe that everything is OK and no harm is really being done. At one time, I myself thought it was all in good fun.

But people who spread paranoia do not wish us well. Now, maybe their hostility is entirely unconscious. There is, however, no difference in the *impact* of their hostility, conscious or unconscious. Maybe they're not aware of what they're doing. Maybe they're possessed by the Trickster. But paranoia is the primary weapon in any decent toolbox of psychological weaponry. You use paranoia to produce a schism in your target's mind between reality and unreality, or perhaps more basically, between the truth and falsehood.

That schism is desirable in order to get the target to believe what is false. Or to believe in whatever the hell you want them to believe in.

Cui bono?

Psychoanalyst Heinz Kohut once said that the way analysis cures is by the laying down of psychological structure. Paranoia destroys by reversing that process. Paranoia is an attack on psychological structure.

Now, perhaps some abductionists are not aware of this. But abduction hypnotists who commune fraternally with psychiatrists/psychoanalysts/hypnotherapists at University or at the Opera House have no excuse. Neither do self-professed ex-intelligence professionals – existential hoaxes – claiming expertise in psychological warfare.

It is often the case that whenever these "intelligence professionals" rear their ugly heads in "the community" they give off a kind of stench of arrogance that smells up their entire presentation. It's worse than the skunk ape. It is an arrogance and an aroma they share with the alien-abduction hypnotists.

They enjoy mocking the intelligence of their audiences. This is the orgasmic release achieved by George Hansen's Trickster: breaching walls between reality and fantasy, violating boundaries, dancing over graves, breaching psychological structural integrity, taking virginities.

In order to get people to believe in the products of what Hansen and others have called "antistructure", you have to tear down structure. The lecturer here and the alien-abduction hypnotists are psychological demolition men. You can't be nice about it. You have to bomb the structure to get it to collapse. You have to mount an assault on common sense and you have to be pretty obnoxious about it, if not criminal. It is a simple process.

To disembowel someone psychologically all you really have to do – and this recalls Marx and Feuerbach's critique of the Capitalist's chopping up the worker and selling his pieces off – is claim that things that are his are not really his. His thoughts are not his. His feelings are not his. His actions are not his. They're all owned by the Capitalist. They are all owned by the Aliens.

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Alien abduction is a process of psychological alienation whereby the abductee is separated and estranged from his own faculties. His faculties are repossessed by the mortgageholders: the alien beings, really the abductionists.

When this alienation is complete, the abductee can be manipulated in whatever fashion the abductionists wish: Alienation through dispossession by deployment of the psychological weapon of paranoia.

This is the paranoid pomography of the mindfucker.

This is why people can say that alien abductees are the chattel of the abductionists. This is why the abductionists complain so loudly when an abductee awakens. They're losing their property. This is the source of the abductionist outrage we've been subject to recently. They're like property owners and the abduction critique to them is organized thievery.

What really is occurring there is, abductees are recovering lost aspects of themselves. It is the return of the self they're going through. Feuerbach would say they are merely gathering back the aspects of themselves they'd projected into the cosmos. Putting the pieces back together. Not selling them off to grandstanding abductionists or sexually screwed up, paranoid-schizoid Repto-religionists.
